



G-Series Dynamic Flash Galleries

G-series Gallery + CMS

Quick Setup

Thx for purchasing a G-series gallery + CMS! File structure and G_images.xml is already setup, so to quickly get the CMS up and running do the following:

1. Locate the following files/folders inside the Standalone folder, and upload them to the same directory on your server, preferably the same directory as the html file you will embed the gallery on:

G01_Standalone.swf (name depending on version)

G_images.xml

G_setup.xml

G_images

G_mp3

G01.html (Html page with swf embedded, for temporary use. Name depending on version).

swfobject.js

G_admin

G_admin.html

2. Grant the following files/folders writing permissions on your server.

(chmod setting 777):

G_images.xml

G_mp3 folder

G_images folder

adminThumbs and **thumbs** folder inside **G_images** folder.

3. Open **init.xml** (G_admin/init.xml)

Specify the absolute path for **upload.php** where it now resides on your server. If you uploaded files to the root of your server, the path will be:

"http://www.myserver.com/G_admin/upload.php"

4. Save **init.xml** and upload/replace it on your server.

5. Browse to the gallery and CMS. If you uploaded files to the root of your server, paths will be:

Gallery: **<http://www.myserver.com/G01.html>**

CMS: **http://www.myserver.com/G_admin.html**

Log in with **LETMEIN**

NOTE! Make sure your browser is set to clear cache when you refresh the page. Otherwise you will not see your new uploaded image(s). Alternatively, try closing the browser and restart it.
